Mrs. Alexander, high school junior/senior counselor, provided the following information concerning college entrance exams.

SAT

Details: contains Verbal and Mathematical Reasoning sections. It is timed and primarily multiple-choice with the exception of short answer responses and an essay. Certain calculators are allowed. Students can re-take the test as many times as needed to improve scores.

Who should take: Preferably juniors in the spring and summer; seniors in the fall. Visit www.collegeboard.com to register for the test, or pick up a registration packet in the counseling center at the high school.

ACT

Details: contains English, Math, Reading, and Science Reasoning with an optional writing section. It is multiple-choice and timed. Certain calculators are allowed. **The test site is available in Sweetwater at the high school cafeteria.** Students can re-take the ACT up to twelve times to improve scores.

Suggestion: answer all questions, leave no oval unanswered.

Who should take: juniors in late fall or spring; seniors in early fall. Visit www.actstudent.org to register for the test, or pick up a registration packet in the counseling center at the high school.
